
Accommodation and meals

Accommodation is based on full lodging (with breaks of course) in Hotel Srbija (<http://www.hotelsrbija.rs/>) in city centre of Vršac, small beautiful multicultural city in Banat, in northern part of Serbia (Vojvodina): <http://www.vrsac.com/>

When arriving to Nikola Tesla Airport in Surčin (or to Belgrade in general), you can take local bus or taxi on the airport, to come to Central bus station. It's number 72 or mini bus A1 (which is directly going to bus station) and get you to Zeleni venac which is 10 minutes from Bus station by walk. But if you use taxi, price will be much bigger. Unfortunately, this part of travel expenses are not covered by the project. Bus ticket is at most 400 dinars (3,5 euros). The same is for Novi Sad if you arriving by bus to there.

On the bus station take direct bus to Vršac. All original tickets save for reimbursement. Attention: before you buy a ticket, consult us on mail, because of travel reimbursement limits per country!

IT IS POSSIBLE TO EXTEND YOUR STAY FOR A MAXIMUM OF 2 DAYS IN TOTAL (1 BEFORE, 1 AFTER, OR 2 BEFORE/AFTER). IN CASE YOUR STAY EXCEEDS THE 2-DAY LIMIT, WE CANNOT REIMBURSE YOUR TRAVEL EXPENSES AND YOU MUST COME AND GO FROM/TO YOUR HOME COUNTRIES. 
